Chest and Waist Measurements

Wetsuit Care: How you care for your wetsuit has a direct effect on how long it lasts. We recommend the following care practices:

- Prior to each use, inspect your wetsuit for loose threads or tears. Wetsuit tears happen after time, especially due to fingernail cuts. This is not a warranty issue, just nature of the beast. If a tear is small, you can repair it using a neoprene adhesive such as Aqua Seal. If it's large, we recommend returning it to the factory for repair. Loose threads should not be pulled. They can be repaired at any Tailor shop or you may choose to return to the factory for repair. Prior to returning anything to the factory, please contact us first. We'll need to determine if it's a warranty or a wear and tear issue. Repairs will be quoted and given a RAR.
- After each use, rinse with fresh water, especially if you've been in salt water.
- When not wearing your wetsuit, turn it inside out and hang it in a cool, dry and shaded place. Sun will fade the neoprene. Keeping it inside out will help prevent the fading process and extend the life of your wetsuit.
- At least once every week, we recommend that you rinse your suit and apply a mild soap to clean it. Hair Shampoo, Woolite, or Oxyclean work well. Fill your bathtub with water and place the wetsuit in the tub with the soap and let soak for 30-45 minutes. If you have a spa/jet bathtub, turn on the jets to circulate the water. DO NOT put your wetsuit in a washing machine or dryer. Always hang dry your wetsuit.
